Hope to see you at the meeting,





Honey Apple Slices

INGREDIENTS:.

1 apple

1/4 cup- peanut butter


2 T - honey

1/4 cup- almonds sliced

1/4 cup - walnuts, chopped

1/4 cup -coconut,shredded

1/4 cup - chocolate chips



DIRECTIONS:

Slice apple into thin rings and remove core. Set aside.

Mix peanut butter and honey together. Spread mixture over one side of apple ring.

Top with almonds, walnuts, coconut, and chocolate chips. Drizzle with honey, if desired.

TIP:

Additional topping options include granola, pretzels, raisins, cereal and sprinkles.
