

Monthly Honey Recipe:

HONEY-GINGER LEMONADE

A Nancy Fuller recipe courtesy of food network. This recipe has beekeepers talking. Let's give it a try using the honey that our honeybees produce. This is sweet but, yet has the spice of ginger with the freshness of lemon. Make it your own.

Ingredients:

You will need water

1 cup honey

About 1/3 cup sliced ginger can leave skin on

1 ½ cups fresh-squeezed lemon juice (you will want to use real lemons)

Ice cubes, for serving

Directions:

- 1. Bring 2 cups water, the honey and ginger to a boil in a medium saucepan over medium-high heat. Turn off the heat and let steep for 10 minutes. Strain and refrigerate until cold.
- Put 4 cups water, the chilled honey and ginger mixture and the lemon juice in a large pitcher and stir until combined. Pour over ice into your favorite vintage glasses.
